Acting President Lance then discussed the need for new blood in the officer line and the need to give Howard Lorson a break after almost 20 years as newsletter editor/publisher. He also passed around a copy of the North Coast newsletter as one example of an electronic newsletter. Dave Hout indicated that many chapters have gone to this approach since it is easier and cheaper to publish.

It was indicated that the donut shaped sanding pads demonstrated by Greg Jensen earlier this year are now available from Packard Woodworking. Bruce Lance also has located a source in Cincinnati that he can give to anyone interested.

Acting President Lance mentioned the need for a new library cabinet as our current one is quite full. Don Karr indicated that the large amount of magazines in the library were not used very much and he would recommend putting them in this year's auction. This would save the need for getting a new cabinet immediately. Several members voiced agreement with this idea but no action was taken.

Lance announced that Stuart Beatty will be conducting a workshop at the Lance workshop next Wednesday and there were still two openings for anyone interested.

The upcoming Lyle Jamieson two day turning demonstration was discussed and preparations finalized. The demo will be at the Old Hartville Kitchen (our current meeting location) on Oct 29 and 30. It will run from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm both days and lunch will be provided. The content of each day is different-to get the full impact, plan to attend both days! Approximately 20 of the members present indicated they would be attending.

The members present indicated a preference for having our annual club auction in December so that Tom Nero could be our auctioneer. Tom will be contacted to see if he is available and willing.

Dues of \$20 for 2005 are now due and payable. Acting President Lance indicated that anyone not paying by December 31, 2004, will be

removed from the membership roster and will no longer receive the club newsletter. Dues may be paid to Treasurer Lou Mineweaser in person or by mail (5378 Duffield Drive, Hudson, OH 44236).

A raffle was then conducted and resulted in \$51.00 being collected for the club.

Jim Duxbury, former member visiting in the area, then demonstrated his string powered top and explained how he makes them. Later in the meeting, he also indicated that the mouthpiece respirator that he invented (and is now sold in several woodworking catalogs) has been certified by NIOSH as an escape device.

Dave Hout announced that he now has a new series appearing on the DIY Network TV channel called Woodturning Techniques. Check www.diy.net.com for proper time and channel in your area.

Several members then explained the turnings they had brought to today's meeting. Bruce Lance explained his technique for creating off-center turnings and exhibited a unique lidded box made using the technique. A general discussion was then held with various members contributing tips on methods of mounting work on the lathe.

A large number of Christmas Tree decorations were contributed by the members at this meeting and Acting President Lance thanked all those who had contributed today or in the past. We now have enough ornaments to properly fill the tree that will be auctioned shortly after Thanksgiving by the Mercy Memorial Hospital Burn Center to aid in their work with patients.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 am.
