Jim Bohmer presented the July program, an all inclusive primer on turning. Jim began with demonstrating some of the many ways you might hold a piece of wood for turning. The advantages of turning between centers which allows you to make adjustments as you turn. Jacobs chucks are good for making bottle stoppers and for use with pen mandrels. The use of face plates, screw chucks, and glued on waste blocks was covered. Several types of scroll chucks with an even greater variety of available jaws, and different ways of applying them to the work was discussed. Jamb chucks, Jims version of squeeze chucks which he uses for turning spheres, and finally, vacuum chucks rounded out the large selection of holding devices. Jim went on to give us a few tips on basic tool handling, "start high, rub the bevel, and raise the handle to start your cut." Non aggressive cutting with gouges, scrapers, skewers, and the cut off tool was also shown. Sharpening with the grinder, or diamond stones, green bowl turning and finally safety issues of dust masks and eye protection were covered.
