The July 13, 2019 meeting of Buckeye Woodworkers and Woodturners was held at the Camp Y-Noah outdoor pavilion. President Tom Nellis welcomed all to the annual fund-raising auction. Before the auction started, Tom made the following announcements:

Tom thanked Ray and Diane Marr and their family for providing the luncheon for today's auction. All money donated for the luncheon was donated back to the club.

Tom announced that club secretary Paul Crouse has resigned. Tom asked if there were any volunteers to fill the position. Mark Stransky was then appointed to fill the position for the remainder of the year.

Hartville Tool is in the process of being consolidated with Hartville Hardware. The discounts that were pre-

viously available to club members will continue in some form. All of the details still need to be worked out. Stay tuned for further updates.

Keith is known for turning unique hollow forms, bowls and platters. This meeting will be held at the North Coast Woodturners meeting location in Brecksville due to Camp Y-Noah activities that were previously scheduled. The upcoming Hartville Hardware tool sales are November 22 - 23, 2019 and February 21 - 22, 2020. The store is working with the club to determine if there is an opportunity for the club to conduct hands-on turning sessions with store customers during the sale. Further details will be coming.

The Ohio Valley Woodturners Guild has provided one free admission to their upcoming symposium to BWWT. The admission has a value of \$220 and is for the symposium only. There were 8 people interested in attending so a drawing was held to determine who would attend. Isabelle Quayle was the winner of the drawing.

Those who will be attending the carving and piercing class at Jack Boggio's shop this coming Friday, Saturday and Sunday were given pattern sheets to cut out prior to the class. Participants should also bring 2 or 3 hollow form turnings to carve and pierce.

The September and December BWWT meetings will be held on the **FIRST** Saturday of the month due to schedule conflicts at the North Coast Woodturners. The new meeting dates are September 7 and December 7. This change is being made because there are many BWWT members who are also members of NCWT and will want to attend both meetings.

Vice-President Brent Wells thanked all of the volunteers who participated in the Wednesday night turning sessions with Y-Noah campers. There is a need for additional volunteers for the last session on July 24. Please contact either Brent or Treasurer Dirk Falther if you can volunteer. Just a reminder that BWWT uses the camp facility at no charge and this is a way to pay back the camp for use of our meeting location.

George Raeder gave an update on the annual woodturning show that will be held at the Wayne Center for the Arts in Wooster, Ohio. Those interested in submitting work will need to register and get an entry number at the August meeting. All entries must be turned in at the September meeting. The show will start on September 19, 2019 with an open house and reception from 6:00 to 9:00. The last day for the show will be October 12, 2019. All entries will be returned to the members at the November club meeting.

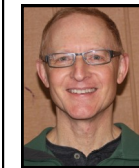
