BWWT Monthly Meeting July 11, 2015

The regular monthly meeting of BWWT was held at the Camp Y Noah park pavilion on the west side of the camp off of Christman Road. The following items were discussed before the membership:

- 1. Pres. Bill Stone thanked all the members for showing up for the yearly auction of BWWT. He felt that everyone would have a good time and go home with quality products that they had bid on. Everyone was instructed to get an auction bid number from the treasurer, Mark Stransky, to participate in the auction.
- 2. Pres. Stone indicated that Darrell Dube is present and will be handing out applications for turned items that will be entered into the Wooster Art Show in Wooster Ohio. Various categories are available for the members turned items to be entered into. All turned items to be entered will need to be turned into the BWWT representative at the next meeting on August 8, 2015. Please box you turned items as requested by the Wooster Art Committee before they are submitted.
- 3. Pres. Stone thanked Ray and Dianne Marr for

their contribution of food for todays event. They have prepared all the food and all donations for lunch will be made to the BWWT treasury.

- 4. The August meeting of BWWT will be held at the regular meeting location at Kastner Hall. We will have John Lucas, a national wood turner, present his turning expertise for all of us to view. He will be in an all day session with us on Sat. and a Hands On session for those who have signed up for Sunday. Please bring a sack lunch for your convenience, since we are a considerable distance from any restaurant in the area.
- 5. Bob Hasenyager will present a demo on Turning a Cryptic Box, later in the fall.
- 6. The Paul Bunyan Show will be held at the county fairgrounds at Cambridge Ohio on October 2-4. Members of BWWT can have booths that have been reserved to show their turning abilities and sell their projects. We will have club representation at one of the booths to show off club activities and several of our members will be doing the turning. There will be no fees charged for the tables if you are interested. Please see Bill Stone for further details.
- 7. Bill Stone mentioned that there is some wood available in Norton that has been stored for 30 years or more. His acquaintance has both walnut and butternut available. Please contact Bill if you are interested in getting some of this wood for turning.
- 8. For todays auction, we have donations provided to us from Hartville Hardware, in Hartville Ohio, Doll Lumber in Southington, Ohio, and from the Mirka Corporation. We also have numerous donations of equipment, tools, and wood from various members of BWWT. All will be available to be bid on during the course of the auction.
- 9. Darrell Dube invited all members of BWWT to turn a project for submission to the Art Show in Wooster,

Ohio. The show will run from Sept. 10 to Mid October. He stated that items should be brought to the next meeting of BWWT and that they needed a tracking number to make sure that all items will be returned correctly to the member. He said that there will be prizes for the winners and it is always an excellent show. He emphasized that we are the biggest draw for the Art Show throughout the whole year.
