BWWT President Tom Nellis had a new member and two guests introduce themselves to the club. Due to our visit to Doll Lumber Inc, the members meeting was kept short to allow the members to tour Doll Lumber's facility, experience the portable milling saw in action as well as purchase some really good turning and woodworking pieces of lumber. The BWWT provided a donation-based lunch of Hamburgers and Hotdogs, provided by the senior leadership of the club and George Raeder, with Vice President Brent Wells and former President David Wells, grilling up a storm. Tom Nellis thanked the personnel of Doll Lumber for allowing us the opportunity to visit their facility on behalf of the whole club. Tom Nellis and Brent Wells informed the club and its visitors about the opportunity to purchase the Nova

Comet II lathes the club is still trying to sell for \$300 in order to replace them with the new Rikon lathes the club needs. The offer was extended to members of both the BWWT as well as the North Coast members that were in attendance.

Tom also announced that the Sep and Dec meetings will be taking place on the first Saturdays of those months in order to accommodate members of dual membership status with North Coast.

Tom requested all donations for the auction and silent auction in July to be turned in at the prior to the meeting of that month.

Brent Wells requested 10 members in support of the Camp Y-Noah's children's Turn-and-Learn on July 10th and 24th. Each participant of the Stransky challenge was afforded the opportunity to talk about the piece they created, and the winner of the contest was announced as Hoby Horn.

Sec. Paul Crouse clarified how to receive the discounts from both Hartville Hardware (in store) as well as Hartville Tool (online or telephonic only) as relayed to him from both business locations. Members in good standing of the club will receive a 10% discount on all woodworking tools and equipment as well as exotic woods only from Hartville Hardware automatically when they utilize their personal telephone numbers at checkout with the cashier, in accordance with Sylvia, manager of special orders and purchasing. In accordance with the Hartville Tool department personnel, all items that are ordered online or telephonically, will receive a 15% discount on any product, but again members must be in good standing and stated either in the shipping information remarks block (online ordering) that they are with Buckeye Woodworkers & Woodturners Club (without abbreviation) or, when ordering over the phone. When purchasing online, the members will initially pay full price for their

product(s). When the order is processed, it will then be discounted, and the discounted price(s) will be refunded. This discount does not include taxes or shipping fees that may apply.
