President Brent Wells welcomed all to the May 31, 2020 meeting of the Buckeye Woodworkers and Woodturners. The meeting was held via Zoom video conferencing. Today's meeting will be a special Show and Tell meeting showcasing some of the member's recent work. There were 31 members signed in for the meeting. Dirk Falther was the meeting host.

Brent began the meeting by recognizing that this had been a very challenging year for our club. Due to the corona virus lockdown, members have not been able to meet since February. The club officers have elected to focus on the health and safety of all members and up until today not had a membership meeting. 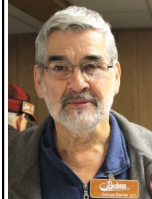

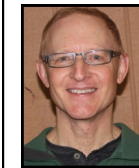
