The August 14, 2021 meeting of the Buckeye Woodworkers and Woodturners was held at the Camp Y-Noah pavilion. There were more than 40 members who attended the meeting. Today's activity will be the annual BWWT fund raising auction. This auction is where most of the funds needed to operate the club are raised.

BWWT Vice-President Marshall Holmes welcomed all to today's auction. Marshall announced that today's auction would include the opportunity to bid on many items on the silent auction table. Included in the silent auction are two opportunities for a 2-hour woodturning coaching session with either George Raeder or Jack Boggio.

Today's lunch is being brought to us by Ray and Diane Marr. Thanks to Ray and Diane for their hard work in feeding this motley crew. Lunch donation is \$5 per person. Thanks Ray!

Marshall let the club members know that the BWWT will be participating in the Beads of Courage program. This program benefits children with serious illness. As each child undergoes treatment for an illness, they receive beads signifying their accomplishments and treatments received. Members who choose to participate can make lidded boxes for children to put their beads in. There are requirements for the size, type and finish for each of the boxes given to the children. 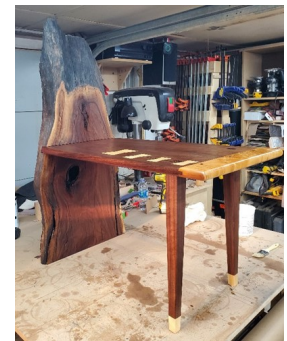

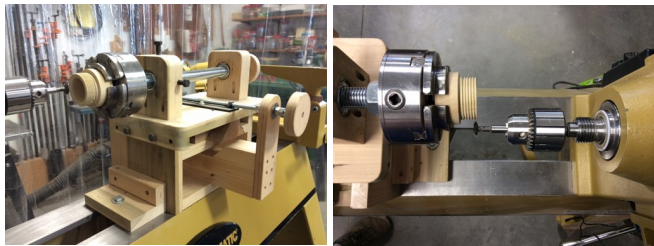

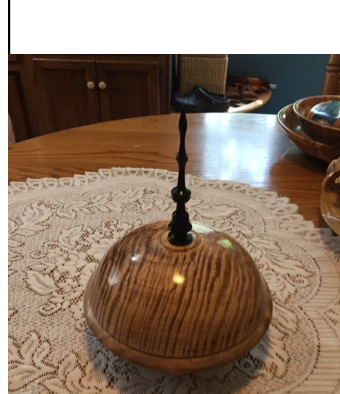
